



IC3 Volunteer Code of Ethics

Volunteers have an integral role in the IC3 conference. They commit themselves to the highest standards of ethical conduct while serving during the conference. This Code of Ethics applies to all persons volunteering with the IC3 Conference, between April 25-27, 2017 and previous conference activity.

- Volunteers are expected to arrive on time at their designated areas and remain until the end of their committed time period. Your participation and promptness will be critical to a successful conference.
- Volunteers should be dressed appropriately in the conference shirt and colored bottom attire, including the assigned name badges.
- Volunteers should eat ONLY in the designated area (volunteer hospitality room). Food is not permitted in other areas.
- Volunteers should treat all attendees and staff respectfully with dignity and pleasantly.
- Volunteers are expected to communicate effectively and Godly, with kindness and in love.
- Volunteers will commit to be good stewards of the Church's facilities and resources.
- Volunteers will consider safety and well-being of themselves and others as they serve in their designated areas.
